Request for Proposals for Fire Number Sign Replacement

Scope of Work: Full replacement of road name signs which includes all necessary coordination with the town, and Chief Demrow of the Edgerton Fire Dept. The company selected will work with the Rock Co. 911 Center, Chief Demrow, and Rock Co. Planning & Development to ensure all addresses are correct. The signs must be installed in accordance to the Rock County Address Sign ordinance #26.05. The Town requests all old signs returned, and will provide an area to store them.

The bid must contain:

- Price for flag style sign, red with white lettering. Sign size is 20"x8"
- Price for fence post. Green or galvanized. 6 ½' long, 1.12 lb per foot steel channel post. Indicate the price difference for green or galvanized.
- Option – Sign post at residence may be recycled if possible. Price for recycle fee.
- Full installation service
- Proof of Insurance
- Any additional charges

Additional Information:

- Town of Fulton has a total of approximately 1560 fire # signs.
- Invoicing needs to be turned into the Fulton Town Hall office within 30 days of completion of project.
- Company hired will contact Diggers Hotline to have each site marked for buried services and complete installation of the new sign.

- There are approximately 25 fire # signs in the town that have been recently replaced, and will not require replacement. A list of those may be obtained from the Town Clerk.
- A copy of the Rock County Sign Ordinance is available upon request.
- The Town may elect to spread this project out over a couple of years depending on the total cost.
