Notice to voters: If you are voting on Election Day, your ballot must be initialed by the municipal clerk or deputy clerk. Your ballot may not be counted without initials. (See bottom of ballot for initials.)

General Instructions

If you make a mistake on your ballot or have a question, ask an election inspector for help. (Absentee voters: Contact your municipal clerk.)

To vote for a name on the ballot, fill in the oval next to the name like this: ●

To vote for a name that is not on the ballot, write the name on the line marked "write-in" and fill in the oval next to the name like this: ●

When voting for President and Vice President, you have one of two choices:

- Vote for candidates on one ticket, *or*
- Write in names of persons on both write-in lines.

A write-in vote for only a vice presidential candidate will not be counted.

QUESTION 2: Shall the School District of Milton, Rock and Jefferson Counties, Wisconsin be authorized to issue pursuant to Chapter 67 of the Wisconsin Statutes, general obligation bonds in an amount not to exceed \$87,000,000 for the public purpose of paying the cost of a school building and improvement program consisting of ADA accessibility requirements, safety, security and capital maintenance improvements at District facilities; additions, renovations and improvements to provide for reconfiguration of grade levels at all District schools and conversion of the current high school to the middle school; construction of a new high school with a swimming pool on land adjacent to the current high school owned by the District; and acquisition of furnishings, fixtures and equipment?
