Slow-No-Wake Removed From Northern Portion of Rock River

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According to the US Geological Survey Gauge on Lake Koshkonong, the water level for the Rock River is 7.85 feet. County Ordinance allows for an abeyance of a slow-no-wake speed restriction when water levels fall below 8.0 feet on the portion of the Rock River downstream from the northern Rock County Line to the Indianford Dam.

Therefore, the Sheriff's Office is removing the previously declared slow-no-wake speed restriction on this portion of the Rock River.

Until the Afton gauge reports water levels below 6.50 feet, the Rock River downstream from the Indianford Dam to the Beloit Rock Town Line Bridge will remain under a slow-no-wake speed restriction. We anticipate water levels to continue to decrease over night and therefore the slow-no-wake on the final section of the river will hopefully be lifted in the morning.
